

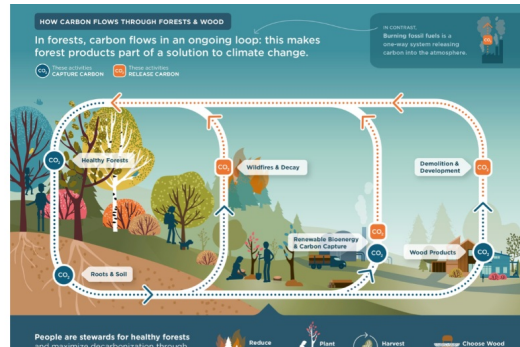

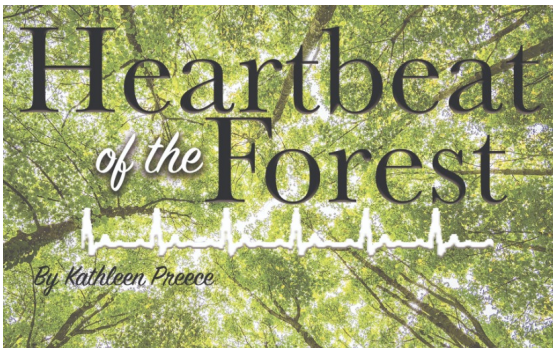

Meet the Team

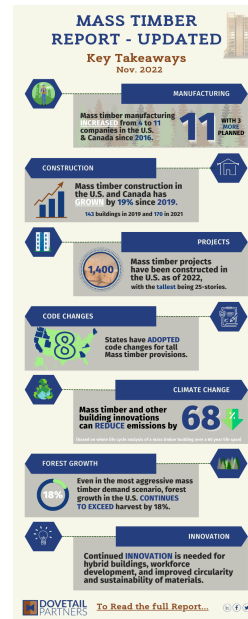
