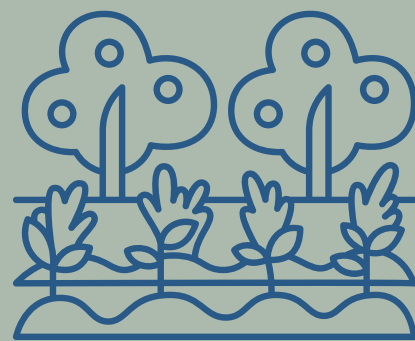

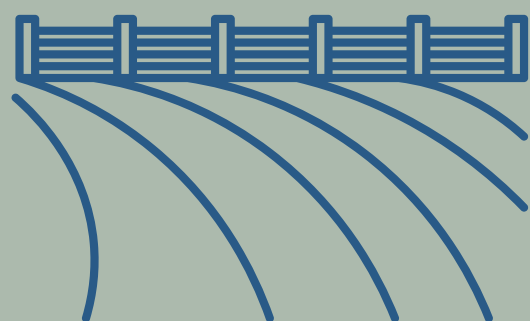


REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE
